



Day 1
May 24, 2022

May 28, 2022

Palace of Parliament

In 1984, Nicolae Ceaușescu buried under the main staircase of "13 Septembrie". "I leave to you this House...", was the expression used by the dictator.

Declared by workers for over 10 years ago, the Palace of the Parliament is haunted by ghosts, who show up at night in the hallways of the largest building in Europe, breaking seals, whistling, or making security systems tinkle.

Iulia Hasdeu Castle

Built in the 1890s, Iulia Hasdeu Castle is the most bizarre of all the haunted castles in Romania!

Bogdan Hasdeu built the castle in memory of his daughter who died young at age 19, per her phantom's request. Driven by insanity, her bones were buried under the building. Many have claimed to see her apparition or hear the piano play on its own.

Disturbing her bones is a mistake for she is known to attack visitors by grabbing their throats.



Snagov Monastery

This place is famed for being one of two places holding the remains of the world's most infamous warlord, Count Vlad Tepes.

Once a small wooden church near to it was destroyed, supposedly even sinking into the surrounding lake. Because of this many locals started to believe the island was cursed causing repetitive ghastly occurrences.

Peles Castle

Peles Castle is considered by many one of the most beautiful castles in Europe, and yet very mysterious. It was the final resting place for several Romanian monarchs.

With such history and intense significance to the town of Peles, could we imagine some of the spirits that remain in this palatial structure?



Pelisor Castle

Pelișor Castle was built between 1899 and 1903 for the King of Romania.

Stories tell of ghosts that haunt the castle's hidden chambers. Visitors have reported hearing clanking chains coming from the walls.

Not too long ago, a paranormal investigation team witnessed apparitions, appearing almost angelic-like.





Cantacuzino Castle

Bucegi Mountains

Many claim these mountains, known as “Romanian Sphinx” are the headquarters of an alien race. Resembling the Egyptian Sphinx of Giza, every November 28, pilgrims gather to enjoy an “energetic pyramid”—made of healing energy around the megalith.

With tales of aliens, portals, and phantom paths, rumors of a subterranean network of tunnels have inspired a whole rabbit hole of Illuminati conspiracy theories.




The Highlights



Râșnov Citadel

This fortress has earned the moniker the “Fortress of Fear” because of its infamous well and the discovery of human bones. The 470-foot-deep well took 17 years to build, but the soldiers were promptly killed for their efforts. Rightfully miffed by this betrayal, they apparently still haunt the well. Elsewhere in the fortress, people have seen dark moving shadows and entities, felt cold spots, and heard unexplained noises.



Bran Castle

The construction of Bran Castle was completed in 1377 for military purpose. Known today as Dracula’s Castle, locals know of the many restless spirits haunt the place.

The castle has one location where a strong scent of violets can be sensed from time to time. Among the more famous spirits believed to be haunting the site are Vlad the Impaler and Queen Maria.

The Black Church

Though this building wears bullet wounds from the 1989 revolution against communism in Romania and its exterior is blackened from a great fire that happened in 1689, giving the church its name, it still holds a much darker feature.

Perched on a high peak is a statue of a young boy, that carry grim legends that will be told during our travel to this city of Brasov.



Sinca Cave Monastery

Sinca Veche Monastery was built in a cave and inside you will feel its magic. Less scary and more spiritual, this cave monastery is steeped in mystery.

Sunlight floods in through an opening in the ceiling as the pious and curious stand in a grotto to soak up the divine healing energy. No one knows who built the underground shrine, but it is thought to be around 7,000 years old.

Cârța Monastery

Famous for the mention and backdrop of the film, "The Nun", this abbey of Carta, its ruins are much more supernaturally intense than its famed reference.

Many witnesses have reported paranormal activity to occur within the Abbey of Carta is sighting ghostly, white monks roaming around the ruins. These imprints remain from their life of suffrage bestowed here. Many are buried in its courtyard.



Teleki Castle

The Teleki Castle looks like an archetypal haunted house, which happens to date back to the Middle Ages.

Its supernatural history began during World War II when it developed a reputation for being intensely haunted.

When there we will learn about the strange tale where wine took a major role in a ghostly legend.

Bánffy Castle

The chilling castle was built between 1437 and 1543 by the Bánffy family, who lived (and died) there until 1944 when they fled from the Nazis. The retreating troops plundered the castle and converted it into a military hospital.

Today, locals have witnessed the sinister shadows of soldiers and heard strange sounds and whispering voices.



Hoia Forest

Hoia Baciú is known as “Europe’s Bermuda Triangle” due to stories of people disappearing among its unnatural, twisted trees. The alleged activity is focused on Poiana Rotunda clearing, where electromagnetic activity is off the charts. Many have witnessed apparitions and disembodied voices. UFOs, lights, and orbs are regularly spotted. People claim to suffer from explained scratches and feeling ill with nausea.

Turda Salt Mine

The first document that speaks explicitly of the existence of the Turda salt mine is dated May 1, 1271, and it was issued by the Hungarian Chancellery.

Today, the Turda salt mine, is visited by thousands, and is known (due to its microclimate) to provide optimal conditions for healing therapies and prevention of various internal diseases. For many, it is also very spiritual.



Fortress of Deva

Placed on the top of a hill, but in spite of the sadness provoked by the state of the building, the traveler feels here the same fascination with history and nature.

Also referred to as a castle, it offers a panoramic outlook, in which “the view from the castle which is very much higher than Heidelberg, is magnificent”





Corvins' Castle

Locally known as Castelul Corvinilor, this fantasy castle does turn into a Gothic horror when confronted with the multitudes of ghosts of its past. Within its dungeons and torture chambers, a Bear Pit (Murder Hole) was used to dispose of live prisoners.

There are many beliefs of Vlad the Impaler's imprisonment here for seven years. He is one of the multitudes of spirits that roam here remembering their agony here.



Poenari Citadel (Castle)

Situated high on a cliff only accessible by climbing up 1482 steps, Poenari Castle was the fortress owned and loved by the horrific Vlad the Impaler. Noticing how incredibly inaccessible this abandoned fortress was, Vlad decided to take advantage and restored it to its former glory.

Using slave labor from the men of his enemies, Vlad rebuilt the path and fortress before impaling the men once the work was complete.

Comana Monastery

Comana was first mentioned in a document in the year 1461, where a certified document signed by Vlad Tepes lays down the boundaries of the monastery.

In the December of 1476, reports were spread of Vlad Tepes' assassination. His head was supposedly carried as a trophy to Constantinople, whereas the rest of his body was buried in the Comana Monastery.



Pădurea Boldu

Crețuleasca

Located in the Boldu Forest, the "Witches Pond" is drenched with stories surrounding its allegedly cursed waters. Popular with the Romanian witches, rituals harness the energy and power contained within.

It is also rumored to be the spot where Vlad the Impaler met his end with a beheading, leading to reports of seeing Vlad's spirit roaming through the forest surrounding the pond.

- ❖ It is the responsibility of the traveler to arrive at a tour start meeting point as established in the specific trip itinerary. If there are meet-up issues, we will attempt to be of assistance, but cannot take the obligation of the cost for your personalized transfers to/from the airport.
- ❖ Package Prices are based on Double Occupancy. Each standard tour of 24 traveler capacities will be limited to three single travelers There is a Supplementary Fee charged for single travelers. There is no discount for Triple rooms. Single/triple rooms are on request basis and subject to availability. They may not be available at all properties.
- ❖ Payment Policies:
 - To secure a tour package, a deposit must be received.
 - Deposits are not refundable.
 - "Soft Reservations" (reservation without deposit) may be cancelled due to limited inventory and high demand. Advanced notification will be given.
 - Interest Free Payment Plans are offered, but must meet the following requirements. The deposit payment is counted towards to reach these thresholds.
 - Within 4 months (120 days) of Tour Start Date: 30% of complete tour package must be paid
 - Within 3 months (90 days) of Tour Start Date: 60% of complete tour package must be paid.
 - Within 2 months (60 days) of Tour Start Date: 100% of complete tour package must be paid.
- ❖ Event Cancellation are considered upon meeting the following standards:
 - Deposits are not refundable at any time, but do contribute to the following penalties:
 - Within 94-60 days prior to Tour Start Date: 30% of complete tour package
 - Within 61-31 days prior to Tour Start Date: 50% of complete tour package
 - Within 30-0 days prior to Tour Start Date: 100% of complete tour package
- ❖ Gratuities and Service Charges: All local service charges are included on confirmed final itinerary items. Tips to your drive/chauffer/guides/special guests are not included and are at your discretion.
- ❖ Government issued Travel Documentation (Passport, VISAs, etc.) are the responsibility of the traveler and not of Mysterious Adventures Tours. Failure to obtain these in a timely manner before travel start date, may lead to cancellation of trip with all fines to be paid by traveler.
